### School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

#### What is it?

This is a plan that describes how we will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning, values the contributions and involvement of families to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that West Bemis Middle will support family engagement and how families can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

#### How is it revised?

Family input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year through an online form. The plan is posted on our school website for families to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online and by mail to ask families for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Families can also give feedback during several meetings and activities during the school year.

#### Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. West Bemis Middle will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.

#### Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is posted on the school website and sent home with all students. Families can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the front office of the school.

#### What is Title I?

West Bemis Middle is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support state and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging state academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and family members a written parent and family engagement policy.

- Participate in our school Parent-Teacher-Organization

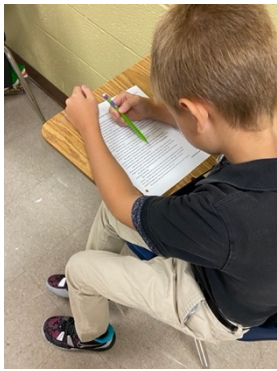
Each teacher may have specific needs that can be addressed through parent volunteers. Please contact your child's teachers to see how you can help or utilize your talents!
