<p style="text-align: center;"><u>SHIRTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • polo style – collared – black, white, gray, or burgundy, short or long sleeved • no holes, cuts or rips of any kind are allowed • sized to fit, neither skintight nor sagging • Any school spirit t-shirt (shirts can not be altered, no slits, cuts or halters) 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>HOODIES</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hoodies can be worn at Liberty. • Hoodies must be in dress code approved colors. Black, white, burgundy or gray or combination. • No camouflage or tie dye allowed. • Hoodies can have writing on them if the writing is one of the school colors. <p>*Hoodies that are not worn within these guidelines will be held by an administrator until the end of the day.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PANTS</u></p> <p>All pants must have belt loops and be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • khaki, navy or black color • no cargo style pants, sweat pants, joggers, spandex, or leggings worn as pants. • no writing, logos, or any style of design should be on any pant • no holes, frayed cuffs, cuts or rips of any kind are allowed sized to fit, neither skintight nor sagging; must be worn at waist/ No one should be able to see your undergarments at any time. 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Skirts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • solid color -black, navy or khaki • hemline must at least touch your finger tip <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Belts:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • must wear a black or brown belt with a silver or gold buckle • buckle no larger than 2" x 2" square and no specialty, logo, oversized or wording allowed
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Outer garments</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A student can wear any coat to school.
