

Dress Code (School Board Policy 6.310)

Students must be in dress code at all times. All **shirts** must be in school colors, either collared polos or school logoed spirit wear. All **pants**, shorts, and skirts must be black, khaki, or navy, or school logoed spirit wear. All jackets, **hoodies**, sweaters, sweatshirts, pullovers, or other outerwear worn in the building must be school colors. If the outerwear displays writing, it must also be school colors and school appropriate. Cell Phone Usage (School Board Policy 6.312)

Cell phones are “Away for The Day” at Liberty Tech High School. Liberty Tech has Green Zones (when cell phones can be used) and Red Zones (when cell phones cannot be used). The Green Zones are the auditorium in the morning when waiting for dismissal to class, and the cafeteria during a students’ scheduled lunch period. All other areas and times are Red Zones. Use of cell phones in a Red Zone will result disciplinary action, including the phone being held by administration until it is claimed by a parent/guardian. Tardies, Skipping, & Absences (School Board Policy 6.200 & 6.300)

Students are expected to arrive to each class on time and begin their work promptly. Students who arrive after the start of class, will be held to the guidelines laid out in the code of conduct (Level 1). Successive tardiness will escalate in consequence for each infraction. Skipping class and unexcused absences will also be held to the guidelines laid out in the code of conduct.
