ESL Identification Procedure

Administer the HLS to Determine the Student's Home Language

- 1. What is the first language this child learned to speak?
- 2. What language does this child speak most often outside of school?
- 3. What language do people usually speak in this child's home?

If all three responses are "English," screening is not required.

If one or more response(s) indicate a language other than English, administer the W-APT or WIDA Screener

K (1st Semester) = 27 or below or K (2nd Semester) = 27 or below on composite; 14 or \checkmark on reading; or 17 or \checkmark on writing

If the student scores:

Grade 1-12 = below 4.5 composite or 4.0 or below on any domain

Student REQUIRES ESL Services

If the student scores:

K (1st Semester) = above

27 composite; or

K (2nd Semester) =above

27 on composite; above 14 on reading; or above 17

on writing; or

Grade 1-12 = 4.5 or above on composite or above 4.0 on all domain Student is NOT eligible for ESL Services
