- Where is the clinic located? Jackson Careers and Technology Elementary School 668 Lexington Avenue, Jackson, TN 38301 with a separate entrance located under the blue awning.
- What are the hours of operation? Monday Friday, 8am to 4pm. Closed on Saturday & Sunday, and Jackson-Madison County School holidays & breaks.

- Who will see my child? West Tennessee Medical Group Family Nurse Practitioner, Ashley Hardee. Ashley is board certified through the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners and has worked in the healthcare setting for 11 years. She received her Masters of Science in nursing from the University of Memphis and has worked the past 6 years in primary and urgent care settings, providing care to a wide variety of patients. Ashley is a local resident of Madison County where she resides with her husband, daughter and two dogs. In her spare time, she enjoys gardening, reading, exercising, and being with family and friends. She is greatly looking forward to serving the community she lives in!
- Who can be seen in the clinic? Students enrolled in Jackson Madison County School System and all faculty, staff, and immediate family of faculty and staff.
- Why do we need a school health clinic in our schools? Our goal is to improve the overall health and well-being of our students. We want to help meet the healthcare needs of our students and families who may not have access to healthcare or have obstacles that prevent them from receiving healthcare such as inability to take off work, transportation, finances, or insurance coverage.
- What services will be provided? Sick visits (sore throat, ear ache, cough, cold, infections, minor injuries), sports physicals, Kindergarten immunizations and physicals, well-child exams, mental health services, and referrals to other services. Lab testing for flu, strep, covid, and mono will be available.
- How are services paid for? For patients with insurance coverage, West Tennessee Medical Group will submit claims to their insurance company (standard co-pays apply). For patients without insurance, services will be provided on a sliding-scale fee based on income and assistance can be provided to sign up for insurance coverage.
- What if I want my child to be seen in the clinic when I send them to school? Parents are welcome to sign up for a MyChart account online to schedule appointments by scanning the QR code below, or call the clinic directly to schedule. Walk-ins will also be accepted. \*Consent forms are required before the student may be seen in the clinic. They can be completed by parent/guardian walking in to school health clinic to complete, or going to the school front office to request the forms.
- Will transportation to the clinic be provided? Parents/guardians will be responsible for providing transportation to and from the clinic location. We can also arrange for a visit from the Nurse Practitioner to your child's school.
- How will I know what happened during the visit? If you wish to have your child seen during the school day and are not able to be present, you will be notified by the Nurse Practitioner of any findings or treatment. If any prescriptions are needed, they will be called in to your pharmacy.
