

The Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) is a universal meal plan under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) permitting eligible districts and schools to provide meals to all students at no charge regardless of economic status (Section 104a of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act).

The Jackson-Madison County School District participates in the Community Eligibility Provision for the 2022-2023 school year. The collection of socioeconomic data that is typically collected through Free and Reduced applications is not an applicable process for the Community Eligibility Provision. The classification for all JMCSS enrolled students is CEP free.
