# HIGH DOSAGE TUTORING

### GRADES 1-5

Teachers, paraprofessionals or trained staff will provide on grade-level instructional strategies to support targeted students. JMCSS will offer high-dosage low ratio tutoring to targeted students in grades 1-5 during the school day as well as after-school.

Students will receive support in small groups with a ratio of 1:3, max ratio of 1:4 occurring 2-3 times a week in 30-45 minutes sessions.

Tutoring will occur during the school day. There will also be additional opportunities for afterschool tutoring at each school site. Additionally, there will be community partners approved by TDOE offering tutoring at their sites.

### 4TH GRADERS

Students who were promoted to 4th grade and chose tutoring as their promotion path are required to participate in tutoring with a 90% attendance rate for the entire school year. Failure to comply with this portion of the Third Grade Retention Law as well as showing adequate growth on the 4th grade ELA test, may result in retention in the 4th grade.

(Grades 6-12 will have an option for tutoring as well.)
