### Action Items:

#### 1. Student Transportation Management Policy

**VOTE:** Unanimous

A motion was approved to revise the Student Transportation Management policy. The revised language strengthens expectations and support for our drivers. The updated policy also improves the procedure used to submit bus safety complaints.

#### 2. Suicide Prevention Resolution

**VOTE:** Unanimous

The Board approved a resolution recognizing September 2024 as Suicide Prevention Awareness Month.
