Bus garage recovers, goes extra mile for schools



Retention improves, driver numbers trending up as pay increases

he Covid pandemic, and driver shortages that followed, decimated school Transportation teams nationwide. While that impact was felt locally, our efforts to increase pay and support for all employees over the last year has allowed our bus garage to bounce

back. After dipping to 66 drivers, we're now at 81 with 5 additional drivers completing the training process. The latest pay increase from \$93 to \$111.90 daily has assisted in retaining drivers as well as attracting new and former staff. Service and Support will continue for families.
