Five seniors recognized at 39th annual sports banquet, will continue education

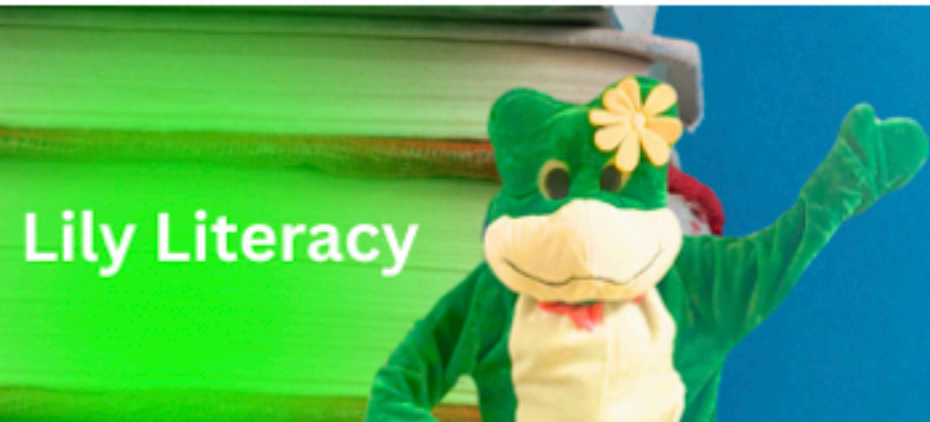
